



SUMMER EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Employment Dates May 15 - August 18 (May 15 to June 2 are training days)

This is a seasonal position, employees are expected to work the entire duration of the scheduled days, with vacation requests being approved at the start of employment.

First consideration of applications begins on February 15.

LEAD COUNSELOR - LITTLE WRANGLER DAY CAMP

This individual will manage one of the summer day camp groups at the Pinedale Aquatic Center. This person will be responsible for facilitating daily operations of camp including the supervision of campers, organizing program schedules and camp curriculum, and coordinating with community entities.

Qualifications: Must be at least 18 years or older; age 21+ preferred for ability to drive campers. Must possess a valid driver's license and have a clean driving record. Adult/Child CPR/First Aid certification required. Experience working with youth is highly desirable.

Terms: This is a seasonal, hourly position expected to work 36-40 hours per week. Hourly wage: \$17.26.

TUESDAY/THURSDAY LEAD COUNSELOR - LITTLE WRANGLER DAY CAMP

This person will have the same responsibilities as the Lead Counselor position above and will oversee the Tuesday & Thursday camp group.

COUNSELOR - LITTLE WRANGLER DAY CAMP
